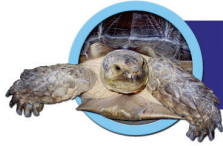

Pet of the Month



Guinea Pig

Guinea pigs are members of the rodent family. Either males or females make good pets. They come in a wide variety of colors and coat types including fuzzy hair, long curly hair and straight hair long enough to braid!

Guinea pigs are affectionate, intelligent animal. As a solitary pet, it may bond closely to you, greeting you with chirps, purrs squeaks or whistles. Guinea pigs do not require as much of your time as some other pets, but the more time you spend with them, the more interactive they will be. Making good pets for young children, their larger size easily accepts the sometimes rough affection of children. If left alone on the floor, they won't disappear and will rarely bite when handled.

They are very active creatures and enjoy running through tunnels and negotiating mazes. Guinea pigs live an average of 4 to 6 years but can live up to 10 years. Guinea pigs are strict herbivores and need special guinea pig pellets that contains vitamin C. This is provided in guinea pig pellets. Guinea pigs do need their toenails trimmed regularly. The standard is to trim their nails at least once every 6 months. Here at the store, we can clip their nails for you for \$10.00.

Their cage should include a large water bottle, a non-tip food dish or hopper, a hayrack and a mineral salt wheel. You should also provide a house for them to sleep in.

Guinea Pigs make a great first pet for children of all ages!
